
The kit contains detailed specialist instructions to suit the beginners. With this kit, you can make a piece of art without any prior skills in embroidery.

During the reign of the Romanov dynasty, this icon was one of the most important and holiest, and was considered the patron of the dynasty.







Saint Nicholas the Wonderworker



from poverty and penury: people place the icon at home to bring in prosperity.









Christ Pantocrator











Our Lady of Tenderness



The icon was located in the cell St. Seraphim of Sarov. St. Seraphim anointed the sick with oil from the lamps that burned before cell icon, and that healed them. When people refer to Our Lady of Tenderness, they pray for the healing of ailments or disease.



Christ In The Crown Of Thorns

The image of Christ in the Crown of Thorns first appeared in the Russian iconography in the late 17th century, and is a borrowing from the Catholic paintings. This icon depicts Christ in dungeon. According to the legend, before the execution, guards crowned Christ with thorns, mocked and taunted him. This icon is used by people as support before important novitiates, like court hearings or change of job. It protects from evil thoughts and depression.












Guardian Angel



According to the Orthodox and Catholic views, Guardian Angel stays invisible as he accompanies a person who keeps his love to God throughout life. The Angel's task is to help salvation, to mentor in faith and piety, to protect the body and soul of his wards, and to pray for them to God. People pray before his image to heal headaches or insomnia, to get protection or happiness in marriage. He helps widows and orphans and those in desperation, and saves from sudden death.







Our Lady the Merciful

Miraculous icon of Our Lady the Merciful is located in the capital city of Kars in Mount Athos in Greece, on the altar of the cathedral church. The year of its first appearance is determined as 980, while the glorification came in 1864. Before this icon people pray for happiness in marriage, to cure mental or physical illnesses, in case of accidents or epidemics.










Our Lady «Fadeless Colour»



Our Lady's icon of Fadeless Colour is recognized as one of the most beautiful Russian Orthodox icons. The first original icon was created by the monks of Mount Athos, and it arrived in Russia in XVII century. Before this icon people pray for finding emotional balance, regaining the joy of life. This icon is especially honored by women: young girls use her to pray for a happy marriage, and women who do not have a life partner ask for a lasting family union. Flower in the hands of Our Lady symbolizes her purity and immortal virginity.

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Our Lady of the Gate of Dawn

Our Lady of the Gate of Dawn is the miraculous icon, widely revered by the Orthodox and the Catholics in Belarus, Lithuania, Ukraine and Poland. The icon is located in the Chapel of the Gate of Dawn in Vilnius, Lithuania. It is one of the most beautiful images of Our Lady. People pray to her for the happiness of married couples and protection from the evil interference in families.











Our Lady "Softener of Evil Hearts"



The icon of Softener of Evil Hearts is the strongest in protecting the house or the person from envious people, evil eye, damage or curses. It reconciles the warring, brings peace and harmony. On the icon, Mother of God is depicted alone, pierced with seven swords, that symbolize the sorrow and heart pain felt by her on Earth. Before this icon, people pray for the softening of hearts of the believers. It helps their mental suffering, improves hostile relationships by giving way to mercy.






Our Lady of Jerusalem

According to the legend, the icon of Our Lady of Jerusalem was written by the holy Evangelist Luke in the 15th year after the Ascension of the Lord in Gethsemane. People pray before this icon in sorrow, sadness or depression, for healing of blindness, eye diseases or paralysis, during epidemics or cattle plague, against fire or attacks. Today the icon is kept at Notre Dame de Paris in France.







Our Lady of Vladimir



The icon of Our Lady of Vladimir was written by St. Luke. It is one of the most venerated images of Our Lady. The tsars were crowned and primates of the Orthodox Church were elected before the icon. In its presence, people pray for the humility of the warring, for the softening of evil hearts, for the healing of physical or mental weaknesses, and for the healing of the possessed.







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
